



2022 Silverdale Sprints

**Silverdale Waterfront Park, Silverdale, WA
Saturday - June 4th 2022 at 8:00 am**

Directions & Parking:

- Silverdale Waterfront Park, Silverdale WA [Google Map](#).
- From SR-3 take the NW Newberry Hill Road exit and turn east (down the hill) towards the water.
- At the round-about take the 2nd exit onto Silverdale Way NW then turn right onto NW Byron St
- Canoe trailers and official's boat trailers - turn right at McConnell Ave into the boat launch parking and rigging area.
- There is plenty of street parking but carpooling is advised. The earlier you arrive, the closer you will be to the action.
- Parking at the boat launch has been reserved for the canoe trailers and safety boat.
- If your World Sprints team would like to race a Matahina at the end of the day please contact the race director in advance and indicate it on your registration form by marking "WS" next to your entry.

Schedule & Facts:

- **Clubs are encouraged to pre register by Monday, May 30th**
- Race course will be 250 meters laid out with 7-8 lanes per PNW-ORCA.
- 7:00 am - Registration/Check-in in the gazebo
- 7:30 am – Coach and Steering Meeting in the gazebo
- 8:00 am - First OC6 race
- Race fees per event: \$36 per adult OC6 crew / \$6 per Junior and keiki OC6 crew
- Insurance fee: \$3.90 per paddler covers liability premium to race all day
- The Hui Heihei Wa'a Sprint Regatta is sanctioned by PNWORCA & insured by Paddlesport Risk Management LLC. Race rules and regulations are in accordance with PNWORCA and PRM
- All paddlers must have signed waivers on file with PNWORCA releasing the host club and the association of liability.
- All paddlers or their guardians must also sign the PRM event waiver for that day. Extra forms will be available on site.
- Events may be combined wherever possible and appropriate to save time.
- All canoes must be equipped with life vests, whistles and weighted in accordance with PNWORCA rules
- Each event will start approximately 5 minutes after the last canoe from the previous event reaches the beach
- Awards for the top 3 clubs in both divisions will be presented at the end of the day. AA (20+ events) A (19 or less events)

Special Notes:

- Paddlers must wear adequate foot protection as the beach is tidal and rocky in places.
- Cradles or tires to protect canoes are necessary
- PLEASE DO NOT use stakes to secure tents or canopies (due to underground sprinkler system).
